



Patricia L. Beauregard

July 3, 1953 - November 16, 2021

CANAAN – Patricia L. Beauregard, 68, of Canaan, passed away at the Dartmouth-Hitchcock Medical Center in Lebanon, N.H., on Tuesday, Nov. 16, 2021, after a months-long battle with cancer and with members of her family by her side.

She was born on July 3, 1953, in W. Stewartstown, a daughter to Edward and Francoise (Carbonneau) Bohan. Pat attended local schools, the Academy of Our Lady of Grace in Colebrook, and she was a graduate of Canaan Memorial High School.

After high school, she attended UNH briefly and then went abroad to England for a time, before returning home and working at Solomon's and later Manchester Manufacturing in Colebrook, where she met her husband. For several years, they both worked at Tillotson Rubber Co. in Dixville, before starting the successful screen printing business, Squeegee Printers out of their home in Canaan, which remains a thriving business today.

Pat was a very caring and giving individual, always doing things for others. She was an active member of the Kiwanis Club of Colebrook, and was a past president of the organization. For several years, she was instrumental in organizing the annual Run/Walk half-marathon for the group. She was an avid and talented knitter, and everyone in the family, as well as many friends, have been the beneficiary of her talent; she could make literally anything by knitting. Pat cherished her family and loved spending time with her grandchildren.

She leaves behind her five children, Eric Beauregard of Lexington, Kentucky, Patrick (Christy) Beauregard of Albany, N.Y., Michelle (Michael) Sauve of Mansfield, Mass., Colette (Ricky) Seehaber of Melbourne, Australia, and Stephanie (Joel) Drapeau of Melbourne Beach, Fla.; her mother, Francoise Bohan of Canaan; two sisters, Elizabeth Crete of Belchertown, Mass., and Maureen Blanchard of Beecher Falls; and nine grandchildren.

Pat is predeceased by her husband of 34 years, Richard A. Beauregard in 2008, and her

father, Edward Bohan.

Memorial calling hours will be on Tuesday, Nov. 23, 2021, from 6 to 8 p.m. at the Jenkins & Newman Funeral Home in Colebrook. A memorial Mass will be held the next morning, Wed., Nov. 24, at 11 a.m. at St. Albert's Catholic Church in W. Stewartstown. There will be a reception for friends and family immediately following the service at the American Legion Hall in Canaan.

“ Pat and Dick Beauregard were the very smart and highly efficient central characters of the Tilly Balloon enterprise during their many years with the Tillotson Rubber Co, Inc ., in Dixville. Pat managed the order processing, sales and billing, while Dick managed the considerable balloon printing and packaging department. Even after the balloon manufacturing part of the enterprise had to move to Fall River, Massachusetts, in the early 1990's, the printing, packaging, sales, marketing and customer relations of the enterprise remained at the Dixville factory, under Dick and Pat's capable leadership. . Dick and Pat started their screen printing business after Dick had managed our foil balloon screen printing operation in the Colebrook location which is now occupied by Northern Tire.

Even after printing and packaging were moved to Fall River, Pat continued to run her sales office, with a responsibility that included communications with our sales representatives, our advertising agency and, our customers, whose numbers were in the hundreds, located all over the country, some of whom were the distributors that Neil Tillotson first sold balloons to when he started our family company in 1932. Other worldwide customers she maintained included Hallmark Cards, Flowers Inc. Balloons, Walmart and Mego Toys. She also managed arrangements and staffing of our Trade Shows, here and abroad, as well as our day to day billing, accounts receivable and accounts payable. The balloon business in general, flourished under her quiet strength and person to person management skills.

More importantly, Pat, Dick, their family and ours maintained several layers of friendship, that extended from sugar on snow breakfasts in Quebec to many other family celebrations over the years. Starting their own business and not just maintaining it over many years but growing it and teaching others has been a significant contribution to our communities, by both of them, but Pat's ability to keep her enterprise strong after Dick's loss, as well as her direct community commitment through Kiwanis is a confirmation of her strength, competence and character. Helping Mark in keeping le Rendezvous operating during times of Verlaine's illness was an act of a truly good person. We will miss her.
