COLEBROOK, NH – Mrs. Adrienne T. Carrier, 90, of Colebrook, NH, passed away at her residence on Sunday, February 27, 2011.

She was born in Paquetteville, Québec, on August 25, 1920, a daughter to the late Alfred and Amanda (Giroux) Thibeault. She was educated in Canada, and moved to the U.S. with her husband in 1948.

Mrs. Carrier spent her life caring for her family, and she also worked in the produce department at Lambert's Grocery Store and as a chambermaid at the Colebrook Country Club. She loved to sew, quilt and cross-stitch, and she was an avid walker, often walking up to 3 miles per day with her friends. She was a communicant at St. Brendan's Catholic Church and a member of the Catholic Women's Club.
