



## Aileen L. Brigham

October 11, 1913 - March 20, 2010

WEST STEWARTSTOWN, NH -- Mrs. Aileen L. Brigham, 96, passed away on Saturday evening, March 20, 2010, at the Coös County Nursing Hospital in West Stewartstown, NH, after a long period of declining health.

She was born in Stewartstown on October 11, 1913, a daughter to the late Lyle McAllaster and Addie (Haynes) McAllaster. She attended local schools and graduated from Colebrook Academy in 1930. Aileen married Ceil Brigham in 1934.

For more than thirty years, Aileen was a well-known waitress at the local eating establishments in Colebrook, including the Legion Restaurant and for 18 of those years at Howard's Restaurant. Following that, she worked for twenty years as a bookkeeper at the First Colebrook Bank.

Aileen enjoyed her gardens and all different types of flowers, and she loved time spent with her family.

She leaves behind three children, Roland Brigham and wife Rita of Stewartstown, NH, Edward Brigham of Manchester, NH, and Jacquelyn Stewart and husband Frederick of Milford, NH; seven grandchildren; fourteen great-grandchildren; and one great-great grandchild; as well as numerous nieces and nephews.

She is preceded in death by her husband, Ceil, in 1969; two brothers, Roger and Shirley McAllaster; a grandson, Donald Brigham; and a great-grandson, Corey Stoller.

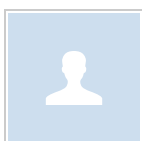

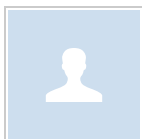
