



Alberta Roy Hebert

August 28, 1908 - January 22, 2007

Mrs. Alberta Roy Hebert, 98, of Coaticook, P.Q., Canada, formerly of Beecher Falls, Vermont, and Pittsburg, New Hampshire, passed away Monday evening, January 22, 2007, at the Coaticook Hospital with her family by her side. Mrs. Hebert was born August 28, 1908, in Lac-Mégantic, P.Q., Canada, daughter of the late Theodore and Olive (Dumont) Roy. Mrs. Hebert was raised in Canada and married Philius Hebert on October 14, 1929. She and her family moved to the United States in 1954 and began working for Shirley Covell in Upton, Maine, as a cook.
