



## Albert "Pete" G. Dion

March 8, 1911 - August 19, 2006

COLUMBIA, NEW HAMPSHIRE -- Mr. Albert "Pete" G. Dion, 95, of Fish Pond Road, Columbia, New Hampshire, passed away Saturday evening, August 19, 2006, at his home surrounded by his loving family. Mr. Dion was born March 8, 1911, in Berlin, NH, son of the late Henry and Marie (Collette) Dion. Mr. Dion was raised in Berlin and attended St. Patrick's School.
