



## Albert R. DuBois

December 23, 1917 - May 30, 2007

SEMINOLE, FLORIDA -- Mr. Albert R. DuBois, 89, of Seminole, Florida and formerly of Canaan, Vermont, passed away Wednesday morning, May 30, 2007, at his residence after a period of declining health. Mr. DuBois was born in Norton, Vermont, on December 23, 1917, a son of the late Arthur DuBois and Anna (Cantin) DuBois. Mr. DuBois was an industrious worker for his entire life. He had many careers, including becoming a master welder and worked during the World War II years for Sikorsky Aircraft in Connecticut.
