NORTH STRATFORD – Allen David Hodge passed away peacefully in his home with loved ones at his side on Wednesday, June 26, 2024, at the age of 73 in North Stratford, N.H. Allen was born the eldest child of Sterling and Aura (Lepine) Hodge on May 13, 1951, in Sherbrooke, Quebec. He graduated from Stratford High School in 1970 and resided in North Stratford for the past 63 years.

Allen dedicated much of his career as a custodian at Stratford Public School, where his commitment to maintaining a clean and safe environment for students and staff was unmatched. His diligence and care gained him the admiration of all those who were acquainted with him.

Affectionately known as "Al-dog," he had a straightforward manner and an independent spirit, living life on his own terms and earning him the deep respect of everyone who knew him. Also, his quick witty sense of humor was appreciated and enjoyed by the enduring relationships he formed with family and friends alike.

His accomplishments in life included many epic deer and turkey hunts in the Northeast Kingdom. Among some of his most cherished memories were the numerous hunting and fishing adventures in Alaska with his brother Jimmy. In addition, Allen thoroughly enjoyed spending time at his hunting camp, the

Longhorn Palace, whether by himself or with family and friends.

In his free time, Allen practiced taxidermy, model railroading, and cheered on his favorite sports teams, the Red Sox, Boston Celtics, Boston Bruins, and New England Patriots. Allen also took great pride in maintaining and decorating his home to reflect his love of hunting, fishing and the great outdoors.

Allen is survived by a loving family including his mother, Aura Hodge of Littleton, NH; sisters Judy Hodge and husband Henry Frechette of Reading, MA, Linda Drummond and husband Jim of Bethlehem, NH, and Susan Planck and husband Ernie of Kansas City, MO; brother Jim Hodge and wife Cathy of Anchorage, AK; daughters Dawn Moore of Derby, VT and Michelle Swift of Chehalis, WA; four grandchildren; one great-grandchild; and five nieces and nephews. Allen's presence will be profoundly missed by all who were fortunate enough to know him.
