PITTSBURG, NEW HAMPSHIRE – Mr. Allen H. Kendall, 84, of Pittsburg, NH, passed away at the Upper Connecticut Valley Hospital in Colebrook early on the morning of Monday, July 24, 2006, after a long period of failing health.
