



Almon J. Kenney

May 24, 1955 - October 21, 2014

CANAAN, VT — Mr. Almon J. Kenney, 59, of Canaan, Vt., passed away on Tuesday, Oct. 21, 2014, at the Dartmouth-Hitchcock Medical Center in Lebanon, NH, with all his siblings by his side after a recent period of failing health.

He was born in West Stewartstown on May 24, 1955, a son to the late Wilfred and Zella M. (Crawford) Kenney. Al was a 1973 graduate of Colebrook Academy.
