BLOOMFIELD, VT – Mr. Alton E. King, 94, of Bloomfield, Vt., passed away late Sunday afternoon, March 27, 2011, at the Upper Connecticut Valley Hospital in Colebrook, NH, with his family at his side.

He was born on September 14, 1916, in Perham, Me., a son to the late Linneus and Edna (Roy) King.

Alton did many different things in his working life, including farming and as a truck driver hauling pulp wood for the Brown Company. He also plowed and sanded roads for the Brown Company, and he was a carpenter for more than 40 years. At one time, he was also a farmer. Alton was an avid bird hunter and fisherman, and he loved snowmobiling. He loved his many long snowmobiling trips with his friends.

He is survived by his son, Charles Smith of Thomaston, Conn.; two brothers, Roy King of Woodland, Me., and Floyd King of Limestone, Me.; and his stepchildren, Claire Steady, Carol Ann Tyler, Betty Williams, Danny and Ronny Martin; as well as his beloved nieces and nephews.

Alton is preceded in death by his first wife, Priscilla (Bouchard) King in 1987; his second wife, Flora (Shatney) King in 1994; three sisters, Angelia Curtis, Iris Bouchard and Rachel Kahn; and a stepson, Shirley "Junior" Martin.
