COLEBROOK – With deepest sorrow, the family of Amanda Taylor Cass, 22, of Colebrook, announces that she left this world unexpectedly on Monday, Oct. 4, 2021, at the Catholic Medical Center in Manchester, NH.

Amanda was born on September 21, 1999, in Colebrook, NH, a daughter to Lisa Champagne and Corey Cass.

Amanda grew up in Colebrook, and Braintree, Vt., where she attended Colebrook Elementary, Braintree Elementary, Randolph Union High School, and Randolph Community Technical Center. After graduating Amanda worked at Lucky's Trailer Sales in South Royalton Vt., where she had wonderful mentors. She then split firewood at Colton Enterprises in Pittsfield, Vt. Amanda knew she belonged back to her roots in the Great North Woods of New Hampshire. She moved to Colebrook and eventually worked for Clark Jeffers, proudly driving heavy equipment (most likely barefoot!) Working in the gravel pit, she took great care not to damage the trucks while loading them up. Most recently, Amanda operated her own welding business. She welded machinery and created amazing pieces of metal art, all while proudly wearing a French manicure and her beautiful long brown hair tucked into her welding helmet.

Those who knew Amanda, even just a little, have lost a shining light in their

lives. Amanda had an eye for beauty and a love for nature, whether it was noticing wildlife in a far-away field or stopping on the side of the road to pick flowers for her mother. Every animal she met she would stop and acknowledge. She could be found hiking, fishing, hunting, catching baby deer, mice, turkeys or turtles, or singing to the birds at night. Amanda was wild and free and will forever be a true angel.

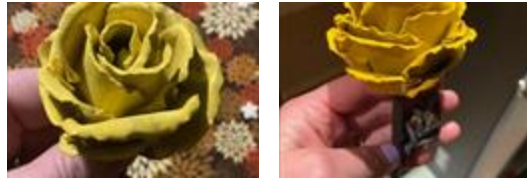
