



## Anna Jean Lavoie

November 3, 1931 - October 29, 2021

BLOOMFIELD – Anna Jean Lavoie, 89, of Bloomfield, passed away at the home of her niece in Columbia, N.H., on Friday, Oct. 29, 2021, after a year-long battle with cancer.

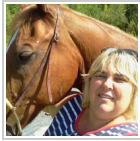

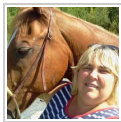
