August 21, 1938 - July 17, 2009

PITTSBURG, NH – Mrs. Anne Rosalie Hewson, 70, of Pittsburg, NH, went to be with the Lord on Friday morning, July 17, 2009, at the Upper Connecticut Valley Hospital in Colebrook, NH, while surrounded by her family.

She was born August 21, 1938, in Rouses Point, NY, the daughter of George and Edna Miner. Anne attended Catholic and public schools in Rouses Point.

She was the originator of the Richford, Vt., Lions Club Santa's Workshop which was located in her home, and she was a member of the American Legion Auxiliary to Post #62 in Colebrook, NH. Anne created a cookbook for both the St. Albert's School in West Stewartstown, NH, and the local Knights of Columbus. She and her husband enjoyed traveling to Europe, Canada, the Maritimes and number of the western states. Her 70 years included living in New York, Vermont, Texas and New Hampshire. She enjoyed reading, soap operas, cooking, her grandchildren, backyard ducks, miscellaneous wildlife, and her pet cats, Mittens and Skittles.

Anne is survived by her husband of 52 years, Marty Hewson of Pittsburg, NH; three sons, Marty Jr. and wife Debra of Derby Line, Vt., Tom and wife Brenda of Colebrook, NH, and Eric and fiancée Bonnie of Loudon, NH; a daughter, Susan and fiancé Michael of Dexter, NY; five grandchildren, Jennifer, Emily, Jordan, Alexis and Rylee; and 5 step-grandchildren; a sister, Sylvia Luthy of

Alma, Wis.; and a brother, Gary Miner of Rouses Point, NY.

She is predeceased by her parents and a brother, Alvin.

Calling hours were held on Monday, July 20, 2009, from 2-4 & 7-9 p.m. at the Jenkins & Newman Funeral Home in Colebrook, NH. A Mass of Christian Burial was held on Tuesday, July 21, at 11 a.m. at St. Albert's Catholic Church in West Stewartstown with The Rev. Craig Cheney as celebrant. Interment followed at St. Albert's Cemetery. Pallbearers were the local Honor Guard of the U.S. Border Patrol. The 4th Degree Honor Guard of the Knights of Columbus was also at the funeral home and the church. Bagpipes were played at the funeral by the U.S. Border Patrol.
