WEST STEWARTSTOWN, NEW HAMPSHIRE -- Mrs. Annette M. Benoit, 76, of West Stewartstown, New Hampshire, passed away Sunday afternoon, February 15, 2009, at the Upper Connecticut Valley Hospital in Colebrook with her loving family by her side.
