



Archie N. Judd Sr.

May 3, 1935 - July 26, 2020

PITTSBURG – Archie N. Judd, Sr., 85, passed away peacefully on Sunday, July 26, 2020, at the Coös County Nursing Hospital in West Stewartstown after a short period of declining health.

Archie was born on May 3, 1935, in Pittsburg to the late Burnham R. and Olive (Heath) Judd. He was raised in Pittsburg and graduated from Pittsburg High School in 1953, and he remained a lifelong resident.

He worked at Ethan Allen for 40 years until his retirement in 1998. At that time, he went on to work at the Pittsburg Transfer Station for another decade, as well as cutting, splitting, and delivering firewood to countless locals.

Along with spending time with his grandchildren and great-grandchildren, one of his favorite pastimes was spending his mornings with friends at Dube’s Restaurant, sharing coffee and good conversation, and where a sweet treat was never far away.

He leaves behind his grandchildren, Nathan Judd of Allenstown, NH; Jeffrey Judd of Pittsburg; great-grandchildren, Zachary and Liliana Judd of Northwood, NH; and a brother, Burnham “Bing” Judd of Pittsburg.

He was preceded in death by his parents and a brother, Willie D. Judd, Sr.
