



## Armand "Poupoune" Baillargeon

August 10, 1935 - July 24, 2009

COLEBROOK, NH – Mr. Armand S. “Poupoune” Baillargeon, 73, of Colebrook, NH, passed away unexpectedly on Friday morning, July 24, 2009, in Colebrook, NH.

He was born in Chartierville, Quebec, Canada, on August 10, 1935, a son of the late Albert and Eva (Charboneau) Baillargeon. Poupoune was educated in Canada, and he married Claire Gagne in 1958.

Poupoune was a well-known local woodsman, and logging was his life. He owned his own logging company for many years, and he also worked for many other area loggers. He was also the former owner of the Moose Grill and Silver Dollar in Bloomfield, Vt. He was known to “love to drink beer, logging, and go poaching with Charlie.”

He leaves behind his wife of 50 years, Claire (Gagne) Baillargeon of Colebrook; two sons, Peter Baillargeon and wife Heather, of Intervale, NH, and Steve Baillargeon and wife Corrine of Glen, NH; a daughter, Sherley McAuliffe and husband, Clem, of Bartlett, NH; five grandsons, Jesse Baillargeon, Tanner Baillargeon, Ethan Baillargeon, Clemson McAuliffe and Griffin McAuliffe; two granddaughters, Raven McAuliffe and Gracie Baillargeon; two great-grandchildren, Savannah and Cyrus Baillargeon; as well as three sisters.

Poupoune is preceded in death by his parents, two brothers and a sister.
