



## Arthur H. Farrar Jr.

November 7, 1959 - October 14, 2023

STEWARTSTOWN – Arthur H. Farrar, Jr., 63, of Stewartstown, passed away at his residence on Saturday, Oct. 14, 2023, with his family by his side and after many years of ill health.

He was born in Newport, Vt., on Nov. 7, 1959, a son to Arthur H. and Irene (Baraw) Farrar, Sr. Art was raised in Colebrook and was a 1978 graduate of Colebrook Academy. Following high school, he entered the U.S. Army and served honorably for 30 years, both on active duty and in the National Guard. He would have liked to have remained in the Army even longer, but his health would not allow it.

Arthur was a friendly person who would do all he could to help someone in need. He worked for several years as a kitchen steward at The Balsams and later at the Wilderness Restaurant. He met the love of his life, Beverly Roby, in 1982 and they were married on Aug. 17, 1985.
