



Arthur L. Greenlaw

October 9, 1914 - May 12, 2007

Mr. Arthur L. Greenlaw, 92, of Nashua, New Hampshire, passed away Saturday, May 12, 2007, at Greenbriar Terrace Healthcare in Nashua surrounded by his loving family. Mr. Greenlaw was born October 9, 1914, in Oceanville, Maine, son of the late Howard and Nettie (Haskell) Greenlaw. Mr. Greenlaw resided in Nashua since 1996, previously living in Manchester with his first wife, Catherine, of 52 years who predeceased him on June 1, 1996. He served four years in the United States Air Force during World War II. Following his honorable discharge, he worked for the New England Telephone Company, and later for AT&T, for 33 years as a telephone line foreman. He was a former member of Pioneer Telephone, the Painters Fish and Game Club, and the American Legion Post #79 of Manchester. Mr. Greenlaw is survived by his loving wife, Gladys V. (Brooks) Greenlaw, of Nashua, NH; a son, Raymond A. Greenlaw of Manchester, NH; a daughter, Shirley A. McGraile of Bradenton, FL; two step-daughters, Leona G.
