COLEBROOK, NH—Mr. Arthur M. Hobart, 67, of Colebrook, NH, passed away at the Coös County Nursing Hospital on Thursday evening, Nov. 1, 2012, after several months of failing health.

He was born on Feb. 4, 1945, in St. John, New Brunswick, son of the late Russell and Delia (Melanson) Hobart.

Since the age of 16, Arthur was a talented television technician, first learning the trade from his father, and later making his own career.
