DANSVILLE, NEW YORK -- Aurore Rouleau passed away peacefully at the Noyes Memorial Hospital in Dansville, NY, on Saturday, January 10, 2009, in her 87th year.

Born in Robinsonville, Québec, on April 26, 1921, to the late Archille Bisson and Anna (Cyr) Bisson, Aurore was one of 18 children. She was educated in Canada, and married Wilfred Rouleau on May 11, 1944, in St. Isadore, Québec. The Rouleaus moved to the U.S. in 1952.

She was a quiet, loving soul, but her presence was always known. Aurore was well liked by all who knew her.
