



## Barbara Killam

August 22, 1938 - January 11, 2004

Mrs. Barbara (Taylor) Killam, 65, of Columbia, NH, passed away tragically Sunday evening, January 11, 2004, after being struck by a vehicle while walking along Route 3 in Columbia.

Mrs. Killam was born August 22, 1938, in Bloomfield, VT, daughter of the late Leroy and Cora (Smith) Taylor.
