



Benjamin F. Leroux

May 28, 1931 - January 27, 2005

Mr. Benjamin F. Leroux, 73, of Colebrook, NH, passed away Thursday evening, January 27, 2005, at the Franklin Regional Hospital in Franklin, NH. Mr. Leroux was born on May 28, 1931, in West Stewartstown, NH, son of the late Alfred and Mina (Collins) Leroux. Mr. Leroux attended school in Stewartstown, NH, and Canaan, VT. In 1951, he enlisted in the United States Army, serving in the Korean War until his honorable discharge in 1953. In 1956, he re-enlisted in the United States Army and was honorably discharged in 1964. In 1967 he graduated from a nursing trade school and worked as an LPN in Waterbury, CT, until 1985 when he took a maintenance position at the Post Office Substation in Waterbury, retiring in 1993. Mr. Leroux then returned to the North Country and lived at the Mountain Village in Groveton, NH, and later moved to Colby Commons in Colebrook in 1994. It wasn't until recently that he moved to the New Hampshire Veterans Home in Tilton, NH. He was also a lifetime member of the D.A.V. Mr. Leroux is survived by two sisters, Barbara Welch of South Portland, ME, and Esther Staples of Moultonboro, NH; and a brother Winston Leroux of Orlando, FL.
