COLUMBIA, NEW HAMPSHIRE -- Mr. Berkley C. Grover, 71, of Columbia, New Hampshire, passed away early Sunday morning, August 26, 2007, at the Dartmouth-Hitchcock Medical Center in Lebanon.

Mr. Grover was born March 2, 1936, in Clarksville, son of the late Glenn and Ruby (Clark) Grover.

Mr. Grover attended school in Clarksville and Pittsburg, and at the age of 18 he began driving truck. He worked as a truck driver his entire life, most recently for Bruce Clogston and Clogston Trucking. 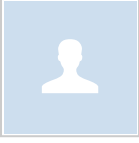
