COLEBROOK, NH—Bernadine M. Keezer, 79, of Colebrook, NH, died peacefully at her home, early on the morning of Saturday, Oct. 20, 2012, surrounded by her loving family.

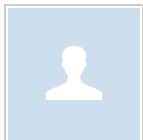

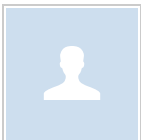
