COLEBROOK – Bethany L. Riendeau, 76, of Colebrook, passed away unexpectedly at the Upper Connecticut Valley Hospital on Tuesday, Jan. 18, 2022, after a brief illness.

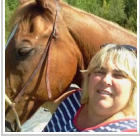
