October 15, 1934 - October 7, 2025

W. STEWARTSTOWN – Betty Ann Stanton, 90, of North Stratford, passed away peacefully at the Coös County Nursing Hospital in W. Stewartstown on Tuesday evening, Oct. 7, 2025, after a prolonged period of declining health.
