WEST STEWARTSTOWN, NH—Mrs. Beverly Blanchard, 73, passed away early on Wednesday morning, September 28, 2011, at the Coös County Nursing Hospital in West Stewartstown, NH.

She was born at home in Colebrook on September 6, 1938, one of 14 children to the late Miles and Laura (Blodgett) Jeffers. Beverly grew up on the family farm and graduated from Colebrook Academy with the Class of 1956. She married William Blanchard and raised her family in Beecher Falls.

In addition to her work as a homemaker, she worked as a licensed nurses' assistant for Goldie's group home prior to her retirement. Beverly enjoyed painting and needlepoint, and loved to travel locally. She collected postcards, as well.
