



## Beverly J. Hylwa

August 16, 1927 - March 12, 2016

WHITEFIELD – Beverly J. Hylwa, 88, died on Saturday, March 12, 2016, of natural causes at the Morrison Nursing Home in Whitefield after a long, happy, independent, and mindful life, filled with the love of friends and family.
