CANAAN – Billie E. Brockney, 80, of Canaan, passed away suddenly early on Sunday morning, Nov. 1, 2015, at her home.

She was born in Boston, Mass., on Oct. 11, 1935, a daughter to the late Walter and Vivian (Boyer) Statkum.

Billie was a dedicated homemaker to her family for her entire adult life, and her love of cooking was deeply appreciated by her friends and family. For a long time, she was also a local Avon representative. As a well-known resident in her community, she also enjoyed being a correspondent for the News & SENTINEL, writing the “Canaan Locals” column for many years. Billie was also a member of the American Legion Ladies’ Auxiliary in Canaan for more than 50 years, and enjoyed attending and participating in the many different events and activities at the Legion. Both Billie and her husband were avid gardeners and took pride in their prize-winning vegetables.

She is survived by her husband of more than 54 years, Keith A. Brockney of Canaan; two sons, Walter ‘Eddie’ Chaloux of Dover, NH, and Michael Chaloux of West Rutland, Vt.; a step-son, Kevin Brockney of Canaan; and several grandchildren, step-grandchildren and great-grandchildren.

committal will be in the Alice Hunt Cemetery in Canaan.

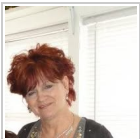
