



## Bradley A. Frizzell

March 30, 1955 - August 27, 2012

PITTSBURG, NH—Mr. Bradley A. Frizzell, 57, of Pittsburg, NH, died suddenly on Monday afternoon, August 27, 2012, at the Upper Connecticut Valley Hospital in Colebrook.

He was born in West Stewartstown on March 30, 1955, a son to the late Wilfred and Nathalie (Whitehill) Frizzell. He was a 1974 graduate of Pittsburg High School.

Brad worked his entire life as a plumber, but his greatest joy was in entertaining people and making everyone laugh. He worked for a short time as a truck driver for WeLog, as well. Brad was known to be completely devoid of any envy or jealousy towards anyone, and always had a positive, happy outlook. He loved to hunt and fish, he was an avid card player, and a talented musician, known for his guitar playing. His comedy shows to benefit others will be remembered by all who attended them. He cherished time with family and friends, and he loved to be at Cowen Hill Camp in Pittsburg. At one time, he held the record for taking the 4th largest buck in state history, which is still on display at Ducret's Sporting Goods. Brad was also a member of Evening Star Lodge, #37, F. & A.M.

He is survived by his two children, Hannah Kingsbury and husband Brandt of New Hampton, NH, and Blaine Frizzell of Ashland, NH; his brother, Roy

Frizzell and wife Nancy of Island Pond, Vt.; his three sisters, Sally Masson and husband George of Canaan, Vt., Catherine McComiskey and companion Guy Cowan of Pittsburg, and Judy Roche of Clarksville; as well as numerous nieces, nephews and cousins.

He is preceded in death by his father in 1979, his mother in 2001, and a brother Peter in 1969.

Calling hours will be on Thursday, Aug. 30, 2012, from 2-4 & 6-8 p.m. at the Jenkins & Newman Funeral Home in Colebrook, NH, with a Masonic service at 5:45 p.m. A funeral service will be held on Friday, Aug. 31, at 11 a.m. at the Trinity United Methodist Church in Colebrook, with Maj. Ethan Frizzell officiating. Burial will immediately follow at the Colebrook Village Cemetery.
