



Carmen Y. Poutre

April 20, 1925 - February 29, 2012

CANAAN, VT—Mrs. Carmen Y. Poutre, 86, of Canaan, Vt., passed away peacefully at her home on Lake Wallace on Wednesday morning, February 29, 2012, after a long period of declining health, and with her loving family by her side.

Born in Coaticook, Québec, on April 20, 1925, she was the daughter of the late Adrien and Aurora (Leclaire) Souliere. She attended schools in Canada. Carmen was married to Gerard Poutre on January 5, 1949.

Carmen leaves behind her husband of 63 years, Gerard Poutre of Canaan, Vt.; a son, Jean-Pierre Poutre and wife Linda of Centerville, Va.; two daughters, Julie Poutre of St. Johnsbury, Vt., and Celine Poutre of Vermont; a brother, Jean-Marc Souliere of Canada; six grandchildren and six great-grandchildren.

She is preceded in death by her parents and a sister.

There will be no public calling hours. A memorial Mass will be held on Sat., March 3, at 11 a.m. at St. Albert's Catholic Church in West Stewartstown, with The Rev. Craig Cheney as celebrant. A committal service will be held later in the spring at St. Albert's Cemetery.
