COLEBROOK, NEW HAMPSHIRE – Carole A. McMann, 70, of Colebrook, NH, died early Thursday morning, August 7, 2008, at the Maine Medical Center in Portland, Me., after a brief illness.

Carole was born on November 7, 1937, in North Stratford, NH, a daughter of the late Kenneth E. McMann and Myrtle (Griffin) McMann. She was a life-long resident of North Stratford until she moved to Colebrook two years ago.

In her younger days, Carole attended Pierce College in Concord, NH, where she received a degree in accounting. She stayed in the Concord area for awhile after her graduation to work in the accounting department of Banks Chevrolet. After returning to the North Country, she provided in-home daycare to a number of Stratford's children. Carole was also a long-time local news correspondent for Colebrook's News & SENTINEL.

She was an active member of the First Baptist Church in North Stratford and a long-time member of the VFW Ladies' Auxiliary. Carole will be remembered by many for her love of cooking.

Carole is survived by her only child, Jeffrey McMann and fiancée, Samantha, of Groveton; their children, Kailene and Evan; two sisters, LaVerna Cass of Colebrook, and Corinne Savage and husband James, of Groveton; and a

brother, Glenn McMann of Nortonville, Texas; as well as many nieces and nephews.

A funeral service will be held on Tuesday, August 12, at 11:00 a.m. at the First Baptist Church in North Stratford with The Reverend Larry Clough officiating.
