



Catarino "Nito" Ramirez

February 14, 1943 - October 2, 2012

STEWARTSTOWN, NH—Mr. Catarino “Nito” Ramirez, 69 of Stewartstown, NH, died very unexpectedly and suddenly on Tuesday, Oct. 2, 2012, in Littleton, NH.

He was born in Tizpan, Mexico, on February 14, 1943, a son to the late Eliseo Ramirez and Carmen Contreras. Nito was an athletic youth, and he was very proud to be a member of the Mexican Olympic rowing team in 1968 when the events were held in Mexico City.

Nito later moved to Massachusetts where he met and married his wife. They re-located to the north country of New Hampshire in 1986 and raised their family here. While living here, Nito worked at the Bose manufacturing plant in Colebrook, and at the R. Haynes Garage and yard on Fish Pond Road in Columbia. He also was a self-employed mechanic for awhile. Although a quiet man who loved to be at home, Nito loved to go to yard sales, and he enjoyed any time spent at Hampton Beach. He will be dearly missed by his family and friends.

He is survived by his wife of 40 years, Sharon Ramirez of Stewartstown; three daughters, Nicole and Cristina Ramirez of Austin, Tex., and Sochilt Brown and her husband Ryan of Phoenix, Ariz.; a son, Eliseo Ramirez and wife Kasha of Colebrook; and five grandchildren, Malik Ramirez, and Bella, Colton, Xavier,

and Tyrus Brown.

Nito is preceded in death by two brothers and three sisters.
