CANAAN, VT — Cecile Lanctot, 92, of Canaan, Vt., passed away peacefully on Sunday, Nov. 24, 2013, at the Coös County Nursing Hospital in West Stewartstown, NH.

She was born on April 29, 1921, in Coaticook, Qué., a daughter to the late Edouard and Marie Anne (Lord) Tremblay. She attended school in Canada at the St. Jean Evangelist School, and was married to Joseph Armand Lanctot on May 12, 1949.

For many years, Cecile enjoyed traveling and living in different parts of the U.S. and world as an Air Force wife. Her husband's duty stations included many U.S. bases, as well as in the Azores, France, and Japan. After Armand retired and they settled back in Canaan, Cecile worked for short time at the Coös County Hospital, and then later at the Beecher Falls Division of Ethan Allen, retiring in 1978. Her hobbies included stamp collecting, and she was also a communicant at St. Albert's Catholic Church.

Cecile is survived by numerous nieces and nephews, and many in-laws.

She is predeceased by her husband of 40 years in 1989; six brothers, Antonio Tremblay, Frank Tremblay, Armand Tremblay, Rudolph Tremblay, Lucien Tremblay and Henri Tremblay; and three sisters, Aemande Tremblay, Pauline Proulx and Germaine Ptushnick.
