



Charles E. Hersom Jr.

March 10, 1933 - October 29, 2021

PITTSBURG – Charles E. Hersom, Jr. 88, of Pittsburg, died on Friday evening, Oct. 29, 2021, at the Upper Connecticut Valley Hospital in Colebrook, after a period of declining health, with his family by his side.

He was born in Exeter, N.H., on March 10, 1933, the son to the late Charles E. and Lydia (Byron) Hersom, Sr. He attended the local schools while living in Exeter and Kittery, Me., and later enlisted in the U.S. Air Force.

Chuck made a career of the USAF where he was trained as an air rescue medic. He was stationed at many different places throughout his career and flew all over the world. He was a combat medic and veteran of both the Korean and Vietnam conflicts.

After his military career, he trained as an occupational safety inspector and worked for several more years in a variety of places, including at the Portsmouth Naval Shipyard and for a period of two years in Perth, Australia.

It was a childhood love of the north country and his passion for hunting and fishing that prompted his retirement relocation to Pittsburg, where he and his family have enjoyed more than 40 years. Chuck truly loved to be in the outdoors and could often be found on his boat either on the 3rd Connecticut Lake or on Lake Umbagog in Errol.

Chuck was also a member of the Free & Accepted Masons for many years.

He leaves behind his beloved wife of 68 years, Maxine (Burton) Hersom of Pittsburg; two sons, Steven Hersom and wife Kristen of Campton, N.H., and Chris Hersom and his partner Jane Millett of Gilford, N.H.; a sister, Betty Jean Vielleux of Rochester, N.H.; five grandchildren, Eric Hersom, Takarra Rezendes, Lovetta Hersom, Will Foustoukos, and Catherine Bernard; and a great-granddaughter, Amara Bernard.

There will be no public calling hours. A graveside interment service with military honors

will be held on Friday, Nov. 5, 2021, at 11 a.m. at the Lake Cemetery on Rt. 3 in Pittsburg.

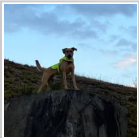
