



Charles W. Towle

January 19, 1934 - November 4, 2009

CLARKSVILLE, NH – Mr. Charles W. Towle, 75, passed away suddenly at his home in Clarksville on Wednesday afternoon, November 4, 2009.

Born on January 19, 1934, in Pittsburg, NH, he was one of four children of Fred Towle and Barbara (Condon) Towle. Charlie attended schools in Pittsburg and Littleton, and in Colebrook where he graduated from Colebrook Academy in 1952. In 1956, he married Joy Bresette.

Mr. Towle worked at several different places in and around the area, including on several farms, at the Jax movie theaters in both Colebrook and Littleton, and driving local school buses. He worked for 16 years at the Beecher Falls Division of Ethan Allen, 5 years for Tillotson Rubber Co. in Dixville, and 5 years for the Coös County Nursing Hospital. In the late 1970s, he established Towle's Market in West Stewartstown, still in operation today and known as a landmark in the town.

Charlie loved to feed the deer on his land, he liked to hunt, and he loved time spent playing with his grandchildren. He was a loving husband, father, grandfather, brother, uncle, and friend to many who will all miss him dearly.

Mr. Towle leaves behind his wife of 53 years, Joy Towle, of Clarksville; two sons, Mark Towle and wife, Shannon, of West Stewartstown, and Earl Towle

of Sunapee, NH; two grandchildren, Echo Towle and Sarah Towle; two brothers, Ronald Towle of Franklin, NH, and Ernie Towle of Georgia; a sister, Sheila Douglas of Newport News, Va.; a very special person who Charlie considered as close as a daughter, Debbie Hikel; and several nieces and nephews.

He is predeceased by his parents.

At the family request, there will be no calling hours. A private interment at the family lot in Perry Cemetery will occur at the convenience of the family.

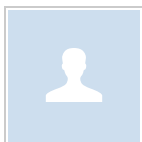
