



Charlotte R. Dobson

May 9, 1927 - December 5, 2015

COLEBROOK — Charlotte R. Dobson, 88, passed away at the Coös County Nursing Hospital in West Stewartstown on Saturday morning, Dec. 5, 2015, surrounded by her loving family.

She was born in Columbia, NH, on May 9, 1927, a daughter to the late Guy and Elsie (Richardson) Kenney. She attended grammar school in Columbia and was a 1944 graduate of Colebrook Academy.

Charlotte worked at many different jobs in her life, including for a short while at the Stratford Plywood Mill, and many years as head cashier at Lambert's Grocery Store. She was well known to help cater funeral luncheons at all the local churches, and will be remembered by many as an excellent cook.

Charlotte loved to play Bingo, read, crochet, and do other crafts, and she loved to attend all the local church bazaars. She was also an avid bowler. She was a long-time member of the Trinity United Methodist Church in Colebrook.

She is survived by her three children, Virginia Smith of West Stewartstown, Eileen Hurlbert and husband, Bruce, of Lancaster, NH, and Jeffrey Dobson and wife Sharon of Colebrook; two sisters, Naomi Covell of Bloomfield, Vt., and Jean Lew of Connecticut; seven grandchildren, six great-grandchildren, and one great-great grandchild; as well as numerous nieces, nephews, and cousins.

Charlotte is preceded in death by her husband, Everett "Buddy" Dobson in 1999; a daughter Sandra Van Curan in 1979; two sisters, Ruth Smith and Carrie Dobson; and five brothers, Richard Kenney, Kenneth Kenney, Herman Kenney, Wilfred Kenney, and Robert Kenney.

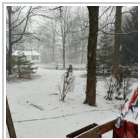
