WESTFORD, VT – Christopher J. Dickson, 53, of Westford, Vt., passed away at his home on Monday, Sept. 8, 2014.

Born in West Stewartstown on March 2, 1961, he was the son of Donald M. and Joan (Scott) Dickson. Chris was a 1979 graduate of Colebrook Academy and a 1984 graduate of the University of Connecticut at Storrs. For many years, Chris had resided in the Burlington, Vt., area where he worked as a pharmacist.

He is survived by his parents, Donald and Joan Dickson of Colebrook; a brother, Dana Dickson and his wife Marlene of Laconia, NH; his sister, Susie Dickson of Kittery, Me.; his nephew, Matthew, and niece Sarah; and his companion, Vesna Gračanin of Burlington.

There will be no calling hours. A graveside service will be held at the family lot in the Colebrook Village Cemetery on Friday, Sept. 19, 2014, at 11 a.m. The Rev. Richard Davenport will officiate.

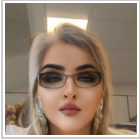
