COLEBROOK – Cindy Sue Hatjialexiou, 64, of Colebrook, died at her home on Friday, Nov. 11, 2022, after a long period of ill health and with members of her family by her side.

She was born in Lancaster on Oct. 30, 1958, a daughter to the late Armand and Lucille (Hook) King, Sr. Cindy was raised in and around the Lancaster area.

Her working life was spent in the family restaurant, alongside her husband and family, all the while raising her five children, until her illness prevented her from doing so. She is predeceased by a daughter, Talia, earlier this year, and a brother, John King.
