REXBURG, ID – Clare Allaire, 76, formerly of Colebrook, died on Sunday, Oct. 18, 2020, in St. Anthony, Idaho, due to complications of the COVID-19 virus.

She was born on Jan. 10, 1944, in Nashua, NH, a daughter to the late Elbridge E. and Cecile A. (Desmarais) Mansfield. Clare was raised in Nashua and was a graduate of Alvirne High School in Hudson. She later attended both Franklin Pierce and Hesser College in Nashua.

For 15 years, Clare worked as a secretary for the NH Dept. of Health & Human Services. She was also a long-time foster parent in the Nashua area. She was a devoted member of the Church of Jesus Christ of Latter Day Saints and she enjoyed playing the organ. She loved hand crafts, including crochet, knitting, sewing and counted cross-stitch. With her husband, she was also a former member of the Civil Air Patrol.

Clare is survived by two brothers, John Mansfield (a.k.a. Brother Maurice, OCD) of Post Falls, ID, and Basil Mansfield of Nashua; two sisters, Sister Marie Mansfield of Arlington, Mass., and Louella Kennedy and husband Allen Kennedy, Sr., of Hudson, NH; as well as a niece, Kimberly Roberts and her husband Michael Roberts, Sr., and their children, Jessica & Justin Tivey and Michael Roberts, Jr.; a nephew Allen Kennedy, Jr., and his wife Julie and their daughter Ashley, all of Hudson; and a cousin, Deborah Dwyer and her

She is preceded in death by her husband of 46 years, Antonio "Tony" Allaire in 2011 and a sister, Susan Utter in 2006.

A graveside memorial service will be held at the Colebrook Village Cemetery on Monday, Oct. 26, 2020, at 11 a.m.
