



## Claudia A. Noel

April 3, 1907 - November 9, 2007

WEST STEWARTSTOWN, NEW HAMPSHIRE – Mrs. Claudia A. (Brousseau) Noel, 100, of West Stewartstown, New Hampshire, passed away late Friday evening, November 9, 2007, at the Coos County Nursing Hospital.

Mrs. Noel was born April 3, 1907, in Norton, Vermont, the fourth child of the late Philip and Marie (Morency) Brousseau, the family for which Brousseau Mountain is named.

At the age of 19, she married Laurent Lavertue in April, 1926, and gave birth to four daughters in succession: Doris, Cora, Jeannette and Louisa. All of the children were born on Brousseau Mountain with the exception of Louisa, where the family made their home. The Lavertues sold the farm in 1940, building a home on Averill Road. She lost her husband in the fall of 1945 and later married Louis Noel in August of 1946, and moved to Groveton where Marie Claudette was born in 1947. The family built a home in Groveton in 1949, which they sold in 1953, and moved to Norton that November. There they remained until 1994 when Mr. Noel passed away. Again, she managed by herself and in August of 1997, she became a resident of the Coos County Nursing Hospital.

Having celebrated her 100th birthday this past April, Mrs. Noel is survived by three daughters, Doris Carrier of Colebrook, Cora De La Bruere of Derby, VT

and Jeannette McCoy of Tuscon, AZ; 23 grandchildren; 50 great-grandchildren; and 24 great-great grandchildren with one great-great grandson to soon be born.

Calling hours will be held on Sunday, November 11, 2007, from 2-4 & 7-9 at the Jenkins & Newman Funeral Home in Colebrook, NH. A Mass of Christian Burial will be celebrated on Monday, November 12th at 11:00 a.m. at St. Bernard's Catholic Church in Norton, VT with burial to immediately follow in St. Bernard's Catholic Cemetery.
