



Clyde "Sonny" B. Gray

January 2, 1943 - August 19, 2012

COLEBROOK, NH—Mr. Clyde “Sonny” B. Gray, 69, of Colebrook, NH, died late Sunday evening, August 19, 2012, at the Brigham & Women’s Hospital in Boston, Mass.

He was born in West Stewartstown, NH, on January 2, 1943, the eldest son of the late Clyde and Pearl (Riley) Gray. He was a 1961 graduate of Colebrook Academy, and later served with honor in the U.S. Air Force during the Vietnam conflict as a communications specialist. He later attended the Thompson School at UNH and obtained his degree in forestry in 1969.

Sonny’s career was always in the woods, as a self-employed, certified professional logger. An avid hockey enthusiast, he was a fan of the Montreal Canadiens. Although a very private man, he was a member of the Nulhegan post of the VFW #5243, the American Legion, the NH Timberland Owners Association, and Evening Star Lodge, #37, F. & A.M.

He is survived by his wife of 44 years, Suzanne (Dion) Gray of Colebrook; two daughters, Stephanie Gray-Lemay and husband Ryan of Littleton, NH, and Sara K. Gray of Colebrook; two brothers, Sheldon Gray and wife Elaine, and Michael Gray and wife Melanie, all of Colebrook; 3 grandchildren, Genevieve, Gaege and Gabriealla Lemay; a niece, Darcy Gray; a nephew Christiaan Gray; and an aunt, Eva Patnaude of West Stewartstown.

Calling hours will be on Wednesday, Aug. 22, 2012, from 6-8 p.m. at the Jenkins & Newman Funeral Home in Colebrook, NH, with a Masonic service at 6 p.m. A funeral service will be held on Thursday, Aug. 23, at 11 a.m. at the Trinity United Methodist Church in Colebrook, with The Rev.
