



## Corey T. LeMoine

July 10, 1985 - October 14, 2025

HIGHGATE, VT – It is with deep sorrow that his family announces the sudden passing of Corey T. LeMoine (age 40), who tragically lost his life in an accident on Tuesday, October 14th, 2025, in Highgate, Vt. He was born on July 10, 1985, in Peterborough, N.H. Corey grew up in Colebrook, N.H., but spent the majority of his life in Vermont.

He had a deep passion for poetry and culinary arts. In his personal belongings, we discovered a desire to see his poetry published-an aspiration that reflects his heartfelt commitment to art and expression. Corey attended McIntosh College in Dover, N.H., where he studied culinary arts, a field that allowed him to combine his creativity with his love of cooking.

He is survived by his two beautiful daughters, Mylee Machia in Swanton Vt. and Emma Scanlon in St. Albans Vt.; his mother Lisa (Daniel) Hebert, Colebrook; his father Thomas LeMoine in Michigan; sister Lenaya (Brandon) Burns of Amesbury, Mass.; step-siblings, Corey (Becky) Hebert of Dunbarton, N.H., Chris (Christina) Hebert Colebrook, Kim (Rich) Byda of Norfolk, Mass., and Kelly (Ben) Houle Goffstown, N.H.; and several aunts, uncles, and cousins.

He will be deeply missed by those who were lucky enough to know him. The accident that took Corey's life serves as a stark reminder of how fragile life
