



Dale J. Jock

November 29, 1940 - May 10, 2024

COLUMBIA – Dale J. Jock, 83, of Columbia, passed away at his home on Friday, May 10, 2024, after a brief illness.

He was born in Bangor, N.Y., on Nov. 29, 1940, son to the late Lester and Effie (Avery) Jock. Dale was a veteran of the U.S. Army, serving honorably in Korea in the years just following the conflict there.

Dale's career was as a truck driver and heavy equipment operator. For a long time, he was an over-the-road trucker, and he later worked for the local car dealerships in transporting new and traded vehicles into the area. He drove a truck while working for Gary Covell in Pittsburg for a time, worked for the N.H. DOT on Ricky Parker's crew, and his last employment from which he retired was for Wells Excavation in Colebrook.

Dale loved to fish, and he also enjoyed perusing local yard sales for tools and other knick-knacks. He loved tinkering on old lawnmowers, and in his later years (because he missed them when they were first broadcast while he was on the road), he loved catching up on old westerns on TV. He was a talented guitar player and played in the "Mountain Gold" band for many years.

He is survived by his partner of the past 49 years, Kathy Arsenault of Columbia, and her daughter Karen Washburn and her husband William, and

son Alexander; five children, Debbie Warren of Florida, Rhonda Cancel of N.Y., Rod Jock of N.Y., Darrin Jock of Pittsburg, and Brett Jock of Lisbon, N.H.; four brothers, Earle, Keith, Marvin, and Merle Jock; four sisters, Brenda Garlock, Wanda Reynolds, Sheila Mulverhill, and Melody Sage; 16 grandchildren and 6 great-grandchildren.

He is predeceased by his wife at a young age, Gloria (Chase) Jock.

There are no public calling hours. A celebration of Dale's life will be held on a later date at the convenience of the family. He will be privately interred in the Hollow Cemetery in Pittsburg.
