



## Damien P. Mahoney

February 14, 1939 - January 7, 2005

Mr. Damien P. Mahoney, 65, of Pittsburg, New Hampshire, passed away at his home on Friday, January 7, 2005. Mr. Mahoney was born February 14, 1939, in Boston, MA, son of the late Thomas C. and Helen (Farrell) Mahoney. He enlisted in the United States Air Force in 1956 and served as a ham radio operator during the Korean War. He was honorably discharged in 1962 and enrolled at Bentley College in Waltham, MA, graduating with a dual BA degree in Accounting and Science. During this period, he also married Maureen Moore.
