



Daniel G. Hebert, Sr.

December 7, 1924 - September 19, 2008

COLEBROOK, NEW HAMPSHIRE -- Mr. Daniel G. Hebert, Sr., 83, of Colebrook, New Hampshire, passed away Friday evening, September 19, 2008, at the Dartmouth-Hitchcock Medical Center in Lebanon, New Hampshire.

Mr. Hebert was born December 7, 1924, in East Hereford, P.Q., Canada, a son of the late Treffle and Florence (Bourassa) Hebert.

Mr. Hebert was raised in Colebrook and graduated from Colebrook Academy, Class of 1942. He enlisted in the United States Navy and served during World War II. Following his honorable discharge, he returned to Colebrook where he owned and operated Daniel Hebert, Inc. At the age of 70, he retired and sold his construction business to his son, Dan, but still remained involved on a limited basis. He also owned and operated the Colebrook Country Club with his late son, Richard, from 1972-1976. His passion was golfing and he was an original member of the North Country Pro-Am Traveling Golf League and a member of The BALSAMS Panorama Golf Club and the Colebrook Country Club. His nickname was "Ace" which was given to him by his friends because of his three hole-in-ones. For ten years, he enjoyed spending winters in Florida with his wife, Bertha, and he served as an active member of St. Brendan's Catholic Church.

Mr. Hebert is survived by his loving wife, Bertha (Lambert) Hebert of Colebrook, NH; a son, Dan Hebert, Jr. and Lisa Gravel of Colebrook, NH; three sisters, Isabelle Brunault of Colebrook, NH, Muriel Lewis of Colebrook, NH, and Rachael Rancourt of West Stewartstown, NH; four grandchildren, Corey Hebert and wife, Becky, of Manchester, NH, Chris Hebert and wife, Chrissy, of Colebrook, NH, Kim Hebert of Norfolk, MA, and Kelly Hebert of Manchester, NH; and several nieces, nephews and cousins.

Mr. Hebert is preceded in death by his parents and a son, Richard Hebert in 1992.

Calling hours will be private. A Mass of Christian Burial will be celebrated on Tuesday, September 23, 2008, at 11:00 a.m. at St. Brendan's Catholic Church with The Reverend Craig Cheney as celebrant. An interment service will follow at St. Brendan's Catholic Cemetery.
