COLEBROOK – Darlene J. Kenney, 71, of Colebrook, passed away peacefully on Friday morning, Jan. 15, 2021, at the Country Village Healthcare Center in Lancaster after a long period of ill health.

She was born on April 14, 1949, in West Stewartstown, the only daughter to the late Emery A. and Lorraine (Lizotte) Cameron, Sr.

Darlene was raised in Rangeley, Me., and was a 1967 graduate of Rangeley High School. In 1968 she married Earl G. Kenney and together they enjoyed 41 years together raising their family.
