EDGEWATER, FLA. – David W. Cook, 86, of Edgewater, Fla. and West Stewartstown, passed away at the Halifax Hospice & Care Center in Edgewater on Wednesday, March 17, 2021, after a long battle with multiple strokes.

He was born on Aug. 6, 1934, in W. Stewartstown, the son of the late Roland S. and Lucille (Bean) Cook. David was a 1952 graduate of Canaan Memorial High School and he served in the U.S. Army from 1956-57.

In addition to working with his father at the family's general store in W. Stewartstown, David also served as postmaster in Canaan for a few years, and then he joined the U.S. Customs & Immigration and worked as a customs inspector, retiring in 1994. He worked primarily at the Canaan border stations, but also did some time in the Bahamas. After his retirement, David enjoyed wintering in Florida and returning home every summer.

David was an avid and active outdoorsman who loved to hunt and fish, play tennis and bocce, and he loved to go out dancing.

He is survived by his beloved wife of 35 years, Suzanne (Pouliot) Cook of Edgewater and W. Stewartstown; a son, Mark Cook and wife Holly of Bethel, Vt., his daughter, Raeann Stearns and her husband Mitchell of Venice, Fla.;

and four grandchildren, Ariel, Spencer, Sarah Rae and Sashalyn; and one great-grandchild, Rowan.

There are no public calling hours scheduled at this time. A graveside interment service, with military & U.S. Customs honors, will be held later in 2021 in the Colebrook Village Cemetery, of which notice will be given.
