PITTSBURG – David E. Hann, Sr., 57, passed away very unexpectedly at his home late on Thursday, Jan. 9, 2020.

He was born in West Stewartstown on Oct. 6, 1962, a son to the late Gerald Hann and Eva Huggins. David was a 1981 graduate of Pittsburg High School and a life-long resident of the town.

For 13 years, he worked at the Beecher Falls Division of Ethan Allen before going into business for himself. Since that time, he was a well-known local contractor and painter who always went the extra mile for his clients.

As anyone who knew him can tell you, hunting was his passion. He also enjoyed snowmobiling, hiking, and fishing, and he was an avid fan of all the New England sports teams, especially the Red Sox and Patriots. David just loved to be doing anything outdoors. He was a member of the Pittsburg Ridgerunners snowmobile club. David will be remembered by everyone as a “Pittsburg legend,” and by his family as the glue that kept them all together.

He is survived by wife of 34 years, Mishawn (Grinnell) Hann of Pittsburg; his four children, David Hann, Jr. of Pittsburg, Blake Hann of Pittsburg, Ashley Hann of Florida and Joseph Hann of Texas; a brother, Kelly Hann of Epsom, NH; two sisters, Jamie Hann and partner Chuck Nachos of Manchester, NH,

and Debra Hann of Colebrook; five grandchildren, Aryonna Hann, Alexis Hann, Phoenix Hann, Joseph Hann, Jr., and Kyra Hann; as well as nieces, nephews and cousins.

David is predeceased by a brother, Christopher Huggins.
