



## Dean E. Scott, Jr.

February 8, 1948 - July 21, 2010

NORTH STRATFORD, NH-- Mr. Dean E. Scott, Jr., 62, of North Stratford, NH, passed away at the Upper Connecticut Valley Hospital in Colebrook, NH, early on Wednesday, July 21, 2010, with his loving family at his side.

He was born in West Stewartstown, NH, on February 8, 1948, a son of the late Dean, Sr. and Louella (Riff) Scott. He was a lifelong resident of North Stratford and attended Stratford Public School. Dean served with honor in the US Marine Corps and served 3 tours of duty in Vietnam.

Dean was an avid hunter and fisherman. He had a love for the outdoors and loved being at camp with his family. He also loved four wheeling with his son. He was a trucker and heavy equipment operator in the North Country for more than 30 years and most always was seen in his big rig. Dean helped to build numerous logging roads through the north country.

He is survived by his wife of 30 years, Irene (Houle) Scott of North Stratford; his three children Deanna Brown of Bethlehem NH, Lisa Scott and Sage Daiello of Canaan, Vt., and Dean (Looper) Scott, III, of North Stratford; five grandchildren, Morgan and Colby Brown, Ayva and Amelia, and Keaton Rousseau Scott; his brothers, sisters and spouses: Reggie and Melanie Scott, of Barre Vt., Sherry Scott of North Stratford, Howard (Dusty) Scott and Sharon of Oklahoma, Esther Scott of Bloomfield, Vt., and Shawna and Keith Fellows of

North Stratford; as well as numerous nieces and nephews.

There are no calling hours. The family will have a graveside memorial service at the Fairview Cemetery in North Stratford on Saturday, July 31, 2010, at Noon. A procession of trucks and big rigs is asked to assemble at 11:00 a.m. at the town common to process to the cemetery.
